**ABC TRAILING TRIAL RULES**

All handlers are expected to be familiar with and to abide by the current ABC Trailing Trial Standard. Copies of the Standard can be obtained from any member of the Trailing Trial Committee, or can be downloaded from the ABC website at [www.bloodhounds.org](http://www.bloodhounds.org).

**HOTEL**

The *Georgetown Inn*, Georgetown, NY will be our host hotel (315-837-4688). This is a rustic hotel with shared baths. Please make reservations by July 25<sup>th</sup>. Well-behaved, crated dogs are allowed in the rooms. There is a restaurant on the grounds. If you prefer standard accommodations: The Econo Lodge in Dewitt (near Syracuse), will accept dogs for a fee. They are located at 3400 Erie Blvd, Dewitt, NY (315-446-3300). If you do not plan to have a dog in your room, the Best Western is located at exit 14 off Rt 81 in Tully, NY on Rt 80 (315-696-6061).

**AUCTION**

Since we are relying on the auction for covering expenses of the trial, please plan to attend the auction following dinner Saturday night. Any monetary or item donations are greatly appreciated to help make this trailing trial a success.

**MISCELLANEOUS**

The trailing site is at Highland Forest and includes wooded areas and moderate terrain; additionally the towns of New Woodstock and Cazenovia are within 5 miles of Highland Forest. Judges and some runners will need to be present Friday through Sunday. Judges, please contact Karen Leshkivich regarding time of arrival and departure, as well as for anything else that we can do.

Lunch will be served Saturday and Sunday at Highland Forest to trial participants.

Spectators are welcome at any and all events, so long as they do not interfere with the main focus of the trials themselves. Interested spectators should show up by 800am at the Sawmill in Highland Forest on Saturday and Sunday. The staging site at Highland Forest is at the Sawmill.

**DIRECTIONS TO THE HOTEL:** The Georgetown Inn is on Rt 80 in Georgetown, NY. From Highland Forest, take a right out of the park onto Rt 80E/Rt 13S, the Inn is on the corner once you reach Georgetown.

**DIRECTIONS TO HIGHLAND FOREST:** *From Syracuse:* Take Rt 81S to exit 14 (Tully). Follow Rt 80 east 9 miles. The entrance to Highland Forest is on your right.

*From the Hotel:* Take Rt 80 west, about 3 miles after the flashing yellow light past New Woodstock (where Rt 13N takes a right), the entrance to Highland Forest is on your left. Follow the main park road to the sawmill on your Right.
